### **2019 WCBG Scholarships for Nontraditional Women**

The GFWC Women's Club of Bowling Green, dedicated to improving the status of women, will provide scholarships to women age 23 years and older. The aim of these scholarships is to meet the needs of the nontraditional student who wishes to return to school or to further her education. The maximum scholarship will be \$2,000.

The award recipient must be a resident of Wood County, Ohio; demonstrate financial need; have earned a high school diploma or GED; and be eligible to enroll or already be enrolled in a post-secondary program of study. Such a program of study may include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Four-year University or College
- Graduate School
- Two-year College
- Technical/Vocational Training

The award will be sent directly to the school upon evidence of matriculation (or enrollment).

In the event the award recipient will not spend the entire amount in one semester/quarter/session, GFWC Women's Club of Bowling Green will retain the balance and disburse the funds as needed for the student's continuation in the program.
